Briefing on the Petition of Holly Brooker: Mandate Internet Service Providers to block rape, bestiality and slavery porn

The Petitions Committee has considered a briefing on the Petition of Holly Brooker: Mandate Internet Service Providers to block rape, bestiality and slavery porn.

We presented our report on the Petition of Holly Brooker: Mandate Internet Service Providers to block rape, bestiality and slavery porn on 4 July 2025.¹ Our report stated on page 8 that the petitioner mentioned there is no way for people to report illegal websites. Our report should have said that the petitioner mentioned there is no way for people to report illegal websites containing bestiality and real rape videos.

We acknowledge this error and thank the petitioner for bringing it to our attention.

To avoid any confusion, we would like to restate:

- People can report websites that they believe contain digital child exploitation material or CSAM (child sexual abuse material) on the Department of Internal Affairs website, which contains referral forms.²
- People can ask the Classification Office to review content.³

We recommend the House take note of our report.
